

RESERVATION WIDE BURN BAN ISSUED

June 3, 2019

THIS BAN IS EFFECTIVE IMMEDIATELY AND UNTIL FUTHER NOTICE

Warm Springs Tribes has declared a State of Emergency due to the current water supply situation. A RESERVATION WIDE BURN BAN IS ISSUED, with dry fuel conditions and lack of water for fire suppression, it is critical we take precautions to help protect the people, property and resources of the Warm Springs Reservation.

A BURN BAN MEANS:

1. **All outside agricultural and residential burning is NOT allowed.**

This includes weed burning, burn barrels, and burn bins.

2. **All HOT WORK in all facilities is banned:** All operations involving open flames or that produce heat and/or sparks. This includes, but is not limited to: brazing, cutting, grinding, soldering, torch-applied roofing and welding.

3. **All fireworks are prohibited.**

4. **Outdoor camp fires are not allowed in a declared burn ban.**

Only cooking in BBQ (propane or charcoal) or camp cooking stove is allowed.

5. **All ceremonial and traditional fires are exempt from this burn ban.**

Recommendation by Warm Springs Fire Management Prevention should be considered before burning.
