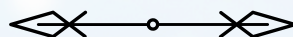
- Ledgers WILL NOT be available by email

Meal times

We understand mornings may difficult to manage we don't want meals times to be that same way. To avoid complications we ask to please give the front desk a call if you know your child is going to be dropped off later than their classrooms scheduled meal times. We do not want them to be hungry in the classroom until their next meal while in our care.

Although the kitchen always has small staples like cold cereal or fruits and veggies on hand for emergencies, if your child is going to be late for breakfast please call no later than 8:50 AM
if you are calling for lunch to be held please call before 12:30 PM.

Outside toys and electronics

We understand drop off times can be chaotic but we would like remind families that ECE DayCare policy has a standard that outlines outside toys and any electronic use is prohibited if not provided by the facility



What does this mean?

- Children need to leave their personal toys at home if they are not brought for nap/quiet time.
- Ipads, games, electronics are not allowed and if stolen, damaged, or lost the ECE facility is not responsible.
- Any toys or electronics used during the day will be related directly to the curriculum suited for your child's classroom.

Early Intervention Services

Located in C-Pod Early intervention provides crucial support for children birth to age 5 with developmental delays or disabilities. Offering services like speech, physical, and occupational therapy. Specialists are on site two days a week (Tuesday and Wednesday) drop in anytime for information at the front desk.
