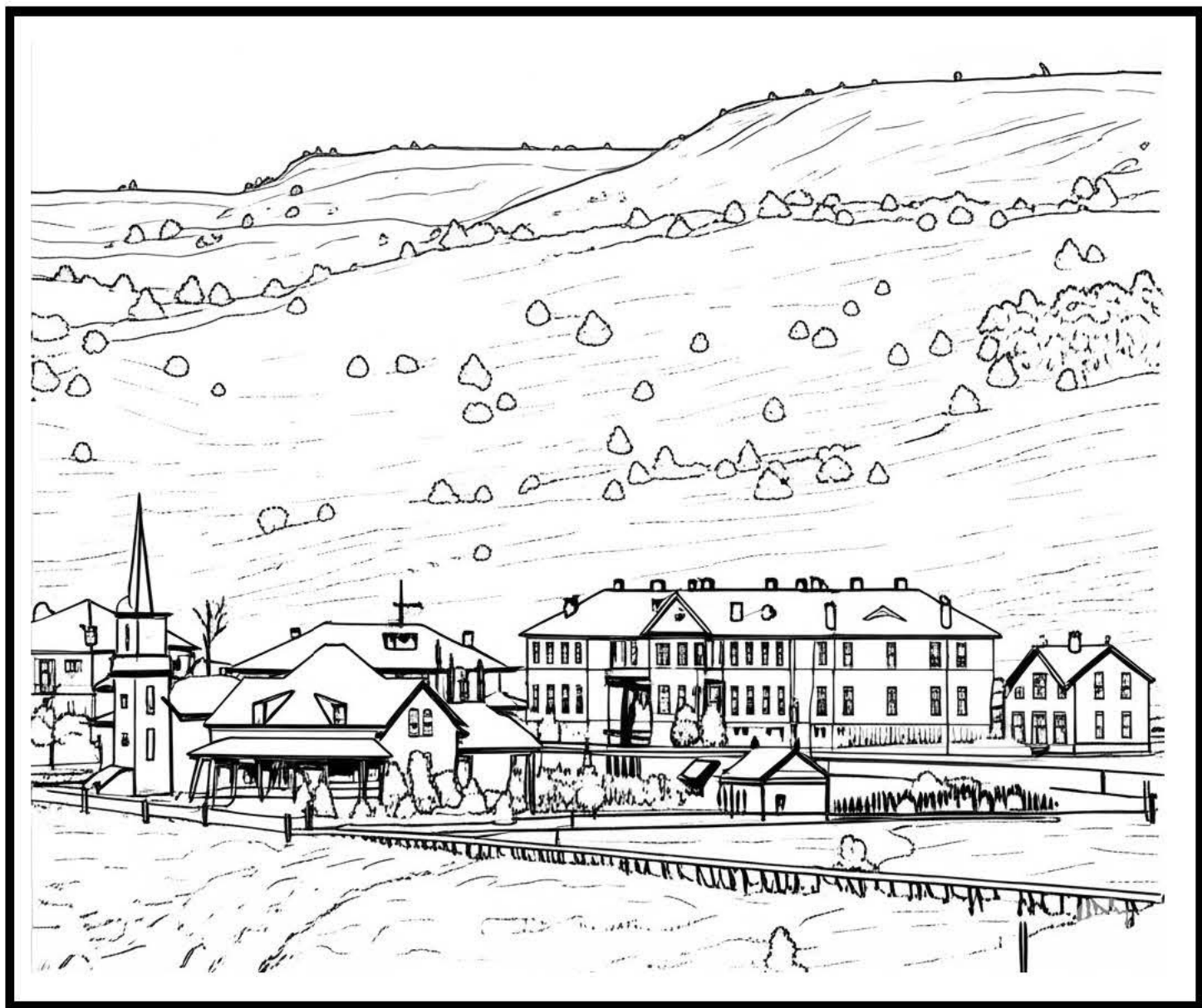


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WARM SPRINGS CAMPUS HISTORY KIDS BOOKLET



OLD BOYS DORM

- The Old Boys Dorm housed youth from outlying areas of the Reservation while they attended elementary boarding school.
- The building was built in the 1930s.
- Now it is used by the Confederated Tribes of Warm Springs Education Branch including the Culture & Heritage Language Program

OLD GIRLS DORM

- The Old Girls Dorm housed girls from outlying areas who were attending boarding school in Warm Springs
- Two older boarding schools began operating on the Reservation in the 1870s. One was in Simnasho and one in the Agency area
- Today the building is the Warm Springs Behavioral Health Center

OLD INDIAN HEALTH CLINIC

- Built in the 1930s this building was the Indian Health Service Hospital, later becoming a Clinic
- When the Warm Springs Health & Wellness Center opened in 1993, the old clinic was renovated and now houses CTWS Branch of Health & Human Services Programs.

OLD TRIBAL ADMIN

- The former Administration Building was built in the 1930s and served as the Warm Springs Tribal Headquarters until 1974
- The facility is now home to Warm Springs Tribal Court, Prosecution, and Public Safety offices

OLD COMMISSARY

- The Commissary, built in 1896, was originally a federal storehouse for distributing commodities to Warm Springs people
- Later, It provided offices for the Branch of Natural Resources
- Renovations are underway to turn the building into a Small Business Incubator by the Warm Springs Community Action Team

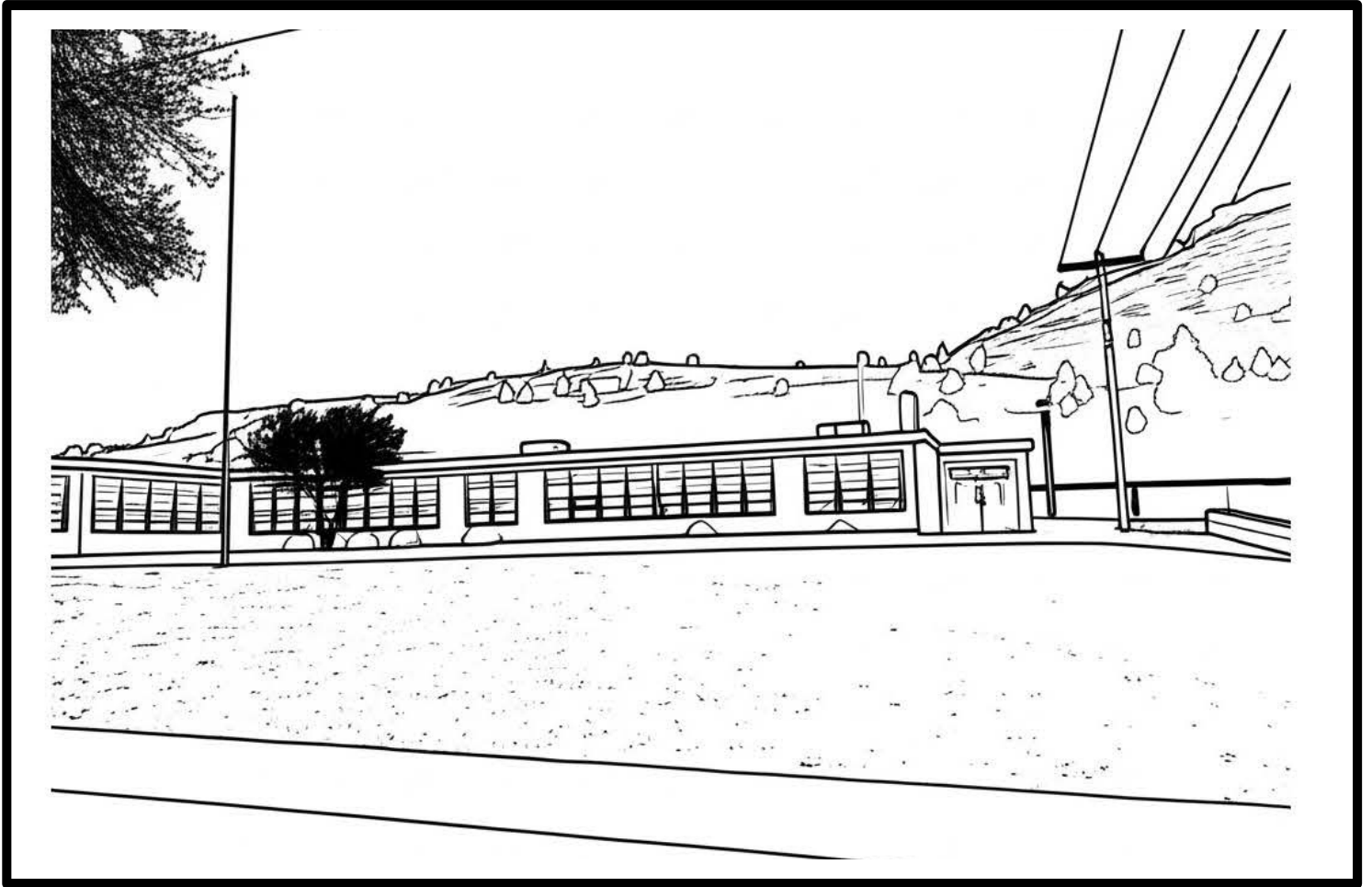

OLD ELEMENTARY SCHOOL

- The original Warm Springs Elementary School building (which served the community for decades) was built in 1938.
- Additional classrooms were added in the 1960s, and in subsequent years, to accomodate an increasing student population.
- Students moved to the new Warm Springs K-8 Academy in 2014

OLD SCHOOL CAFETERIA

- The old school's cafeteria was built in 1957.
- The cafeteria was across the street from the school so students had to cross a street and a field to reach it for lunch
- The facility has been remodeled for multiple public use - including meeting space and a commercial kitchen.

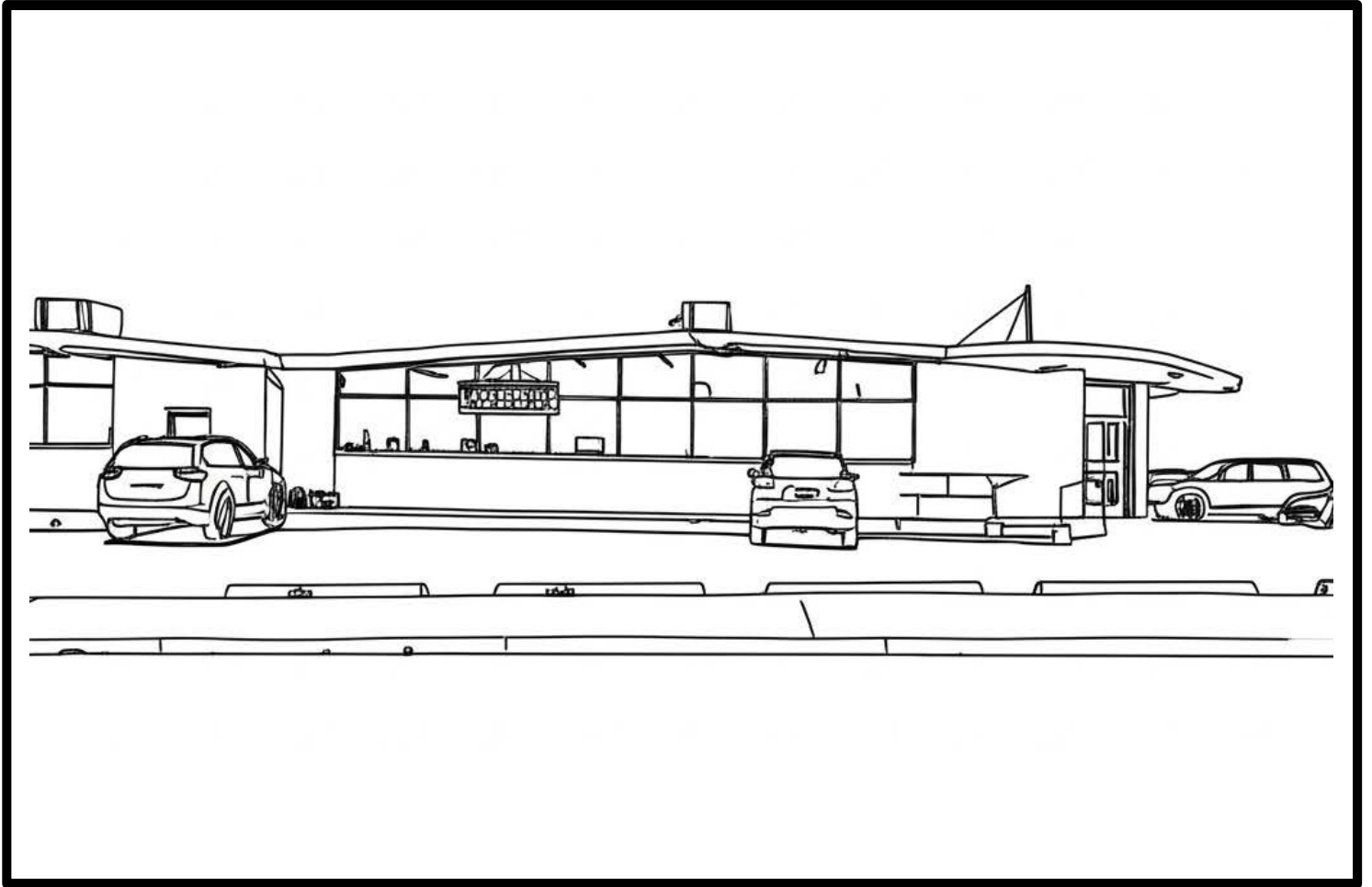

WARM SPRINGS MARKET

- Warm Springs Market (formerly Macy's Market) has been owned and operated by the Macy Family since 1944.
- The building also housed the Warm Springs Post Office until a federal Post Office was built in the mid 1980s.

WYAM YOUTH CENTER

- Originally this building was a store that also had gas pumps
- Over the years, the structure has served as a voting center, teen club, sports store, thrift store & deli.
- Now it's the Wyam Youth Center run by the Warm Springs Community Action Team

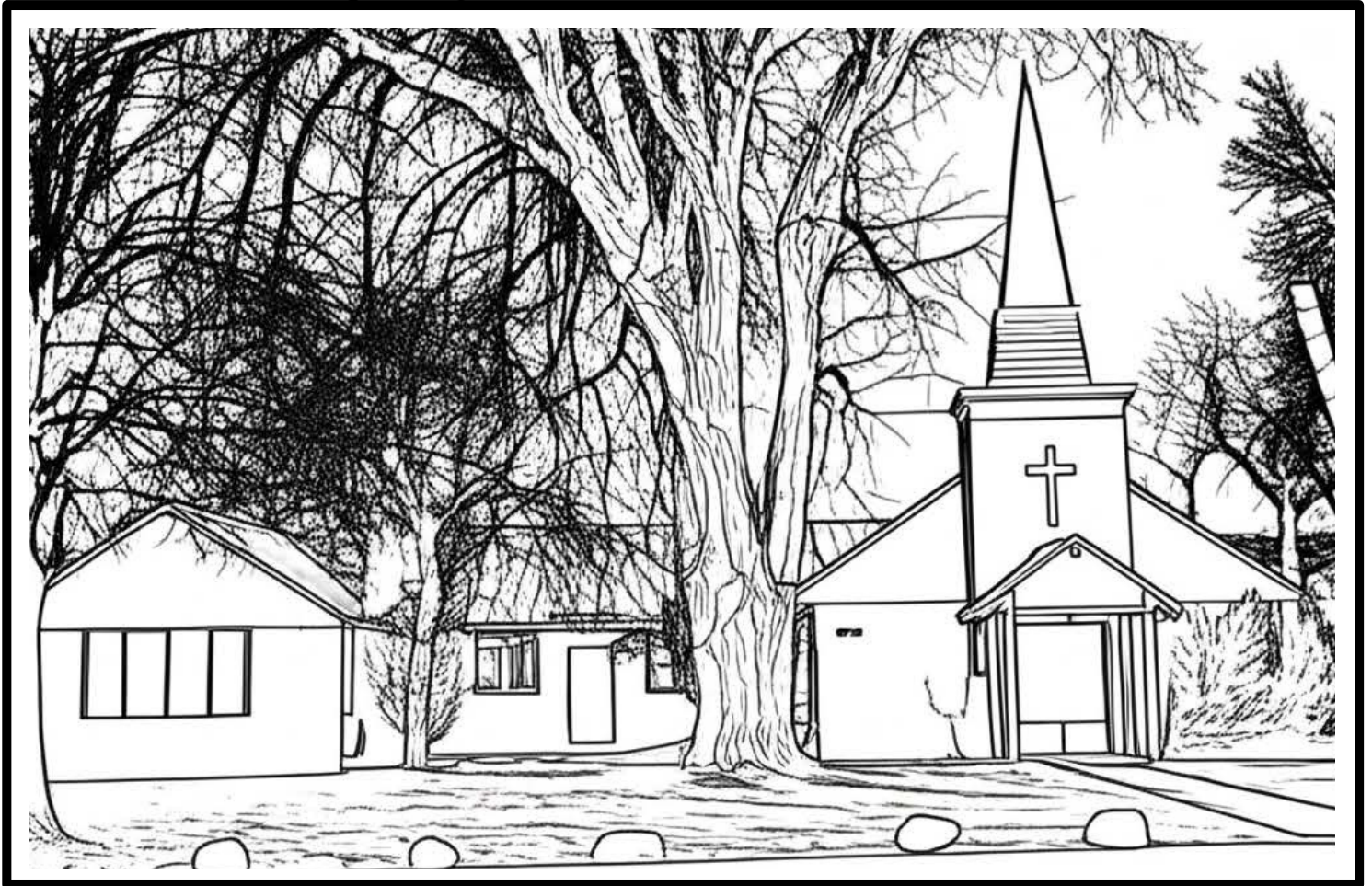

PRESBYTERIAN CHURCH

- Presbyterian missionaries were the first to arrive in Warm Springs in the late 1800's, with churches in Simansho & the Agency Area
- In the 1980s, the church provided space for a Tribal Preschool and Latch Key Program for Youth.

WARM SPRINGS CAMPUS

- “Campus” in the Agency Area of the Warm Springs Indian Reservation, served as a hub for Federal Government operations following the creation of the Reservation by the Treaty of 1855
- Over the years Bureau of Indian Affairs and Indian Health Service employees worked & lived on campus with their families.

WARM SPRINGS HILLSIDE

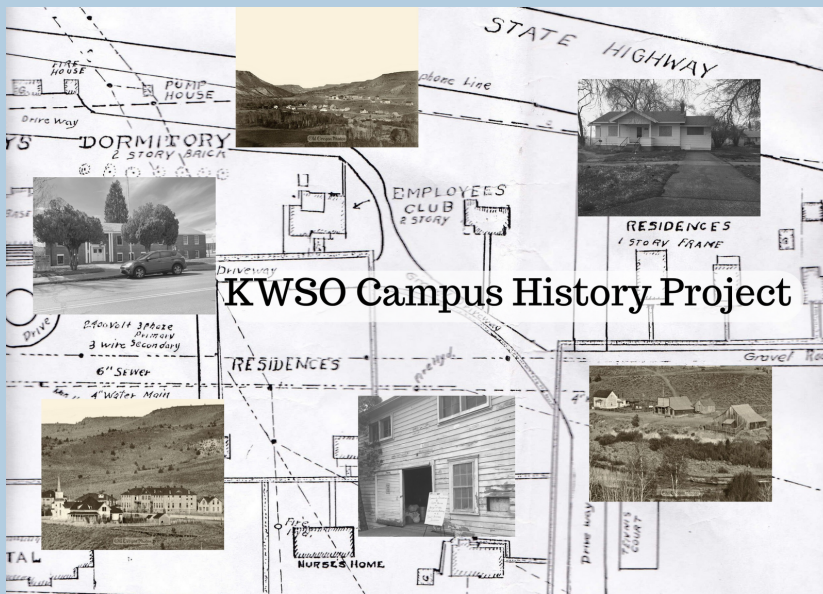
- Easily viewed from Highway 26 and the Agency Area, three teepees are seen on this hillside
