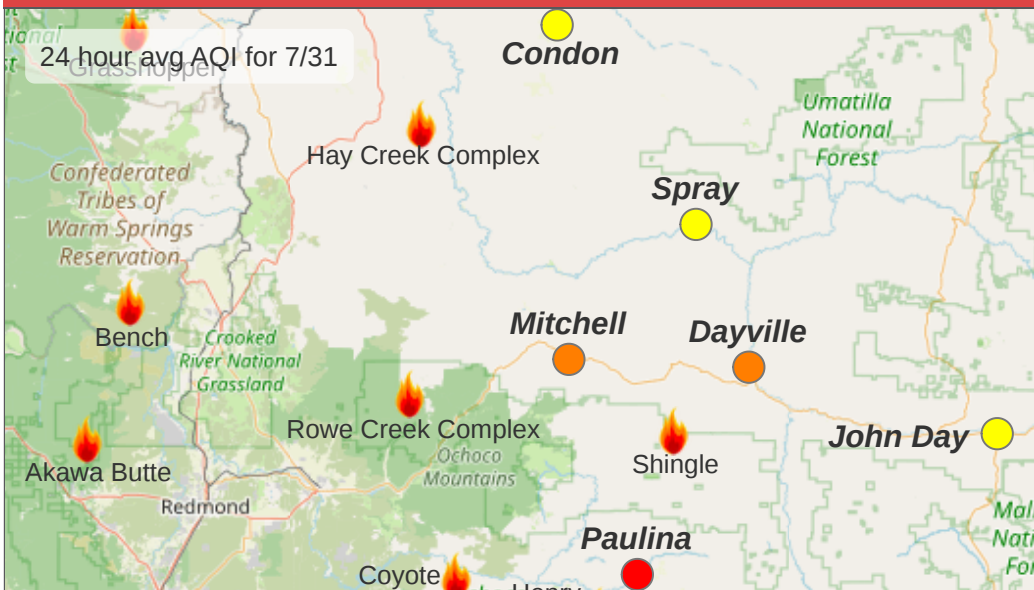

Numerous fires in C Oregon (East) have the potential to send smoke into the outlook area. Associated fire activity is expected to remain active.

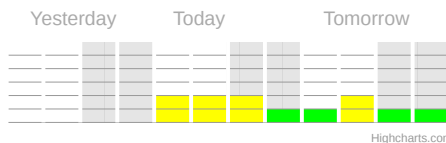
SMOKE

Multiple fires will continue to impact Air Quality across the area. A dry cold front moves through and brings strong northwest winds on Saturday which will likely help clear smoke or at least improve Air Quality for many locations.

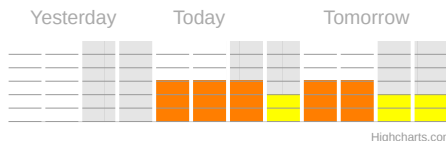
Condon and Spray will see MODERATE Air Quality overall today but brief periods of smoke and up to UNHEALTHY FOR SENSITIVE GROUPS (USG) conditions are still expected, especially this evening. Improvement on Saturday will bring GOOD Air Quality for much of the day with only brief period of MODERATE. Mitchell will have smoke continuing for most of the day with USG Air Quality before some improvement overnight; Periods of USG Air Quality continue on Saturday before more improvement with MODERATE Air Quality by Saturday night. Dayville will continue to see primarily USG to UNHEALTHY Air Quality for today and into the daytime on Saturday before improving Saturday night. Smoke continues to impact Paulina with Air Quality largely remaining USG to UNHEALTHY into Saturday; Potential for improvement by late Saturday though. John Day can expect primarily MODERATE Air Quality to continue.

The strong winds on Saturday may also cause an increase in fire behavior and smoke. With the number of fires in the area Air Quality conditions can change rapidly. View current Air Quality and other Smoke Outlooks at <https://fire.airnow.gov/>.

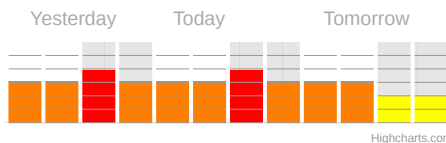
Condon Expect MODERATE Air Quality for most of the daytime, improving to GOOD overnight.



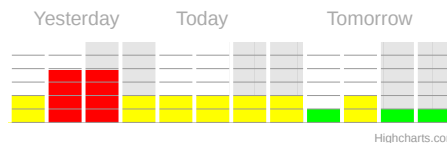
Mitchell Smoke continues with UNHEALTHY FOR SENSITIVE GROUPS Air Quality for much of the day; Improves to Moderate late overnight



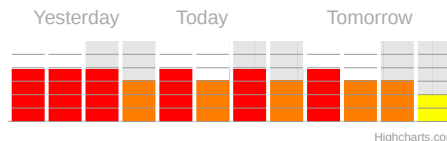
Dayville UNHEALTHY FOR SENSITIVE GROUPS to UNHEALTHY Air Quality continues for most of Friday into Saturday



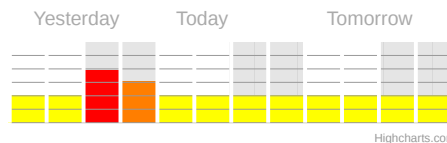
Spray MODERATE Air Quality expected throughout the day and into the overnight with GOOD Air Quality expected Saturday

AIR QUALITY INDEX

	Hazardous (H)	Everyone should avoid any outdoor activity
	Very Unhealthy (VU)	Everyone should avoid all physical outdoor activity
	Unhealthy (U)	People within Sensitive Groups should avoid all physical activity
	Unhealthy for Sensitive Groups (USG)	People within Sensitive Groups should reduce prolonged or heavy exertion
	Moderate (M)	Unusually sensitive individuals should consider limiting prolonged or heavy exertion
	Good (G)	None
