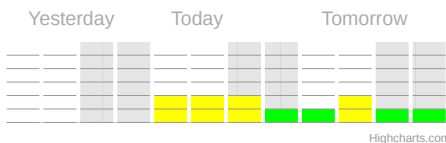

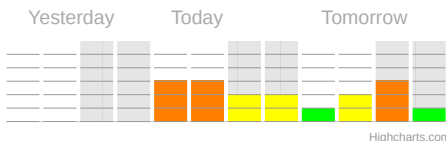

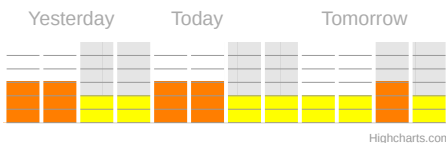
Condon Expect MODERATE Air Quality for most of the daytime, improving to GOOD overnight.



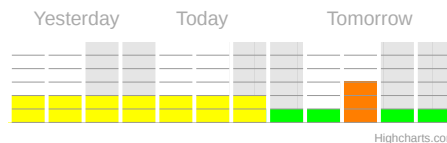
Mitchell UNHEALTHY FOR SENSITIVE GROUPS Air Quality for much of the day before improving in the evening/night with MODERATE AQI



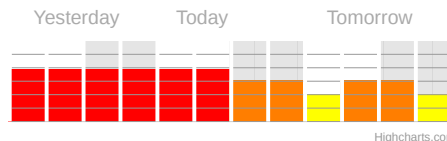
Dayville UNHEALTHY FOR SENSITIVE GROUPS Air Quality likely through the day before some improvement overnight.



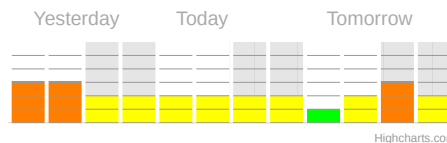
Spray GOOD to MODERATE Air Quality is expected with periods of smoke during the afternoon and evening.



Paulina UNHEALTHY FOR SENSITIVE GROUPS to UNHEALTHY Air Quality looks to continue for much of Saturday.



John Day MODERATE Air Quality overall is likely to continue.



FIRE

Numerous fires in C Oregon (East) have the potential to send smoke into the outlook area. Associated fire activity is expected to remain active.

SMOKE

Some smoke will continue for Condon and Spray but Air Quality should remain MODERATE and improve to GOOD overnight. Mitchell and Dayville will see UNHEALTHY FOR SENSITIVE GROUPS Air Quality for much of the day but improvement is likely late overnight with MODERATE Air Quality expected. Paulina will see periods of UNHEALTHY FOR SENSITIVE GROUPS (USG) to UNHEALTHY through the day with smoke continuing to linger overnight with those USG conditions continuing. John Day will likely see Air Quality remain MODERATE to UNHEALTHY FOR SENSITIVE GROUPS.

Improvement to Air Quality on Sunday for several locations under more northerly winds. Condon, Spray, and Mitchell can expect GOOD to MODERATE Air Quality although some smoke moves through late afternoon to evening which could cause brief UNHEALTHY FOR SENSITIVE GROUPS Air Quality. Dayville and Paulina will both see periods of UNHEALTHY FOR SENSITIVE GROUPS continue. By late Monday, smoke from Washington likely arrives in the area which brings widespread impacts to Air Quality in addition to impacts from local fires.

Strong winds today may also cause an increase in fire behavior and smoke. With several active fires in the area, Air Quality conditions may change rapidly. View current Air Quality and other Smoke Outlooks at <https://fire.airnow.gov/>.

	Hazardous (H)	Everyone should avoid any outdoor activity
	Very Unhealthy (VU)	Everyone should avoid all physical outdoor activity
	Unhealthy (U)	People within Sensitive Groups should avoid all physical activity
	Unhealthy for Sensitive Groups (USG)	People within Sensitive Groups should reduce prolonged or heavy exertion
	Moderate (M)	Unusually sensitive individuals should consider limiting prolonged or heavy exertion
	Good (G)	None
